



Vigilant and cautious personality among workers in the security of sports institutions

Abstract

The first psychology shows a clear interest in studying personality as it represents the distinctive behavior of the individual, as psychologists have emphasized in their studies and research on the importance of some personality traits that can distinguish one person from another. These traits can be prominent in an individual's character. There are many types of personalities, one of which is the conscientious personality, characterized by high alertness. The research aims to build and standardize the conscientious personality scale and identify the dimensions of conscientious personality among sports stadium security personnel. The researcher used the descriptive method with a survey study approach as it suits the research variables and objectives. The research community consisted of (550) security personnel, while the research sample consisted of (407) employees working in the security of sports institutions in Iraq, distributed in the provinces (Baghdad - Basra - Karbala - Najaf - Maysan - Muthanna) representing 73% of the research community. The researcher concluded that all forms of vigilance personality were at a moderate level except for the criticism vigilance dimension, which was at a low level. It was also found that there is a difference in the levels of the dimensions of vigilance personality among the workers in the security of sports institutions, the research sample. The researcher recommended adopting the current scale as a standard for selecting workers in the security of sports institutions and including activities for developing cautious vigilance personality in the curricula of development courses for workers in the security of sports institutions.
