We/you/they are (we're etc.) doing.

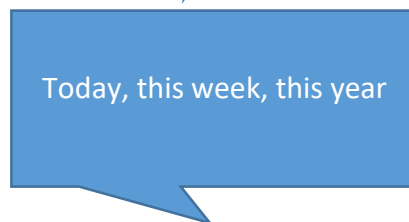
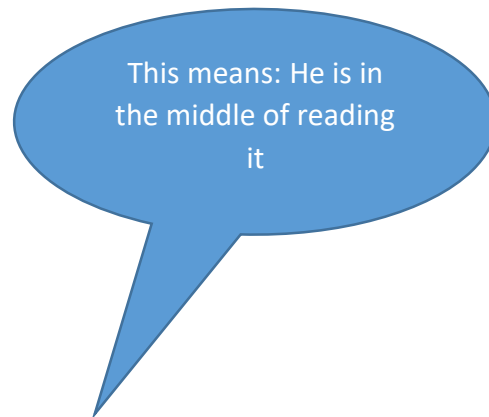
Ex: she is driving **now**.

Ex: I'm reading a really good book at the moment.

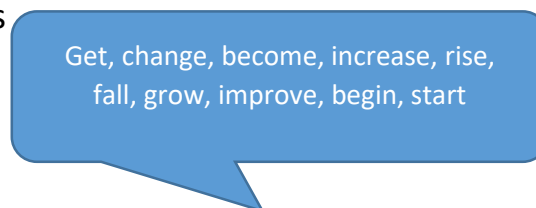
