PRESENT SIMPLE TENSE

- It is called simple because it is simple to form as the verb consists of one word only.
- THE FORM (Affirmative)
- ▶ I/we/you/they+ base verb....
- I work hard.
- You work hard.
- They work hard.
- We work hard.

- ▶ She/he/it +base verb + s.....
- She works hard.
- He works hard.
- It works.
- THE FORM (Negative)
- ► I/we/you/they+ do not + base verb...
- ▶ He /she / it+ does not+ base verb....
- I don't like mango.
- She does not like mango.

- THE FORM (Interrogative)
- ▶ Do + I/we/you/ they+ base verb…?
- Does+ she / he/ it+ base verb....?
- Do you like mango?
- Does she like mango?

THE USES OF THE PRESENT SIMPLE

1- It is used to talk about general truths, habits, and unchangeable situations
Human body contains 206 bones.
He drinks tea at breakfast.
I live in Basra.

2- It is used to talk about repeated actions. She often drinks coffee in the afternoon. He never works after 5 pm.

- 3- it is used to give instructions and directions.
- Open the closet.
- You turn left, then go straight, you will find the bank.
- 4– To state how often we do things.
- I go shopping twice a month.
- 5- To express scheduled events in the future such as time tables and public transportations
- ▶ The train leaves at 5:00 pm.
- We fly to Paris next week.

- ▶ 6- when saying equals doing (we do something the moment we say it), the present simple is used.
- I promise I will study hard this year.
- I suggest you go to dentist.
