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4- Invention (coinage)

 It is the process of adding new words to the English language by inventing them. The result of invention is the invented or coined words)

5- Clipping:

• It is cutting off the beginning or the end of a word or both, leaving a part to stand for the whole. Clipped words result from the process of clipping.

• Example:



Types of clipping:

1-The clipping of the end of the word is the most common type, and most nouns undergo this process.

• Professor-.....prof Examination.....exam mathematicsmath gymnasium.....gym

2-The less common type of clipped words are those in which the first part is clipped

Airplane......plane
Elizabeth.....Beth
Caravan.....van
Telephone.....phone

3-Very few words have their first and last parts clipped

Influenza......flu
Elizabeth.....Liz
Distiller.....still
Refrigerator.....fridge



6- Acronymy

- It means forming a word from the initials or beginning segments of successive words. The words resulted from this process are called acronyms.
- Ex. SWAT.....Special Weapons And Tactics

☐ In some cases the initials are pronounced as letters. For example

- VIPVery Important Person
- PDF.....portable Document Format

☐ In other cases, the initials or the beginning segments are pronounced as a word

- NATO......North Atlantic Treaty Organization
- Radar.....radio detecting and ranging
- NOW......National Organization of Women
