Question word		ask about	Examples
who	من	Subject	Who are you? I'm Tom .
When	متى	الزمن او الوقت (tomorrow...)	When will you come ? Tomorrow .
Where	اين	المكان (to school / at home...)	Where do you go ? To the club .
Which	اي	التفضيل أو الاختيار (the red car ..)	Which car do you like ? – The red car . Which boy is taller :Ahmed or Ali? Ali.
What	ما/ماذا	غير العاقل (car / dog ..)	What did you buy? – A car.
Why	لماذا	السبب (because – to – for)	Why didn't you come? – Because I was ill.

Whose	لمن	الملكية (Ali's / his ...)	Whose book is this? - It's Sam's book.
How	كيف	المواصلات أو الحال (by car)	How do you go to work? – By bus.
How old	كم عمر	العمر 23 years old	How old are you? 10 years old.
How many	كم عدد	العدد (two / three)	How many pens do you have? -1 pen.
How much	كم ثمن	4\$	How much is this dress? – 70 \$
How far	ما بعد	5 km far	How far is your school? –2 km far.
How long	كم طول	4m long	How long is this bridge? 13 m long. How long will you stay ? - For 2 days

Questions with question words

1 Questions can begin with a question word.

what	where	which	how
who	when	why	whose

Where's the station?

Why are you laughing?

Whose is this coat?

How does she go to work?

2 *What*, *which*, and *whose* can be followed by a noun.

What size do you take?

What sort of music do you like?

Which coat is yours?

Whose book is this?

3 *Which* is generally used when there is a limited choice.

Which is your husband? The blond one or the dark one?

This rule is not always true.

What newspaper do you read?

Which newspaper do you read?

4 *How* can be followed by an adjective or an adverb.

How big is his new car?

How fast does it go?

How can also be followed by *much* or *many*.

How much is this sandwich?

How many brothers and sisters have you got?

Questions with no question word

The answer to these questions is *Yes* or *No*.

Are you hot? Yes, I am./No, I'm not.

Is she working? Yes, she is./No, she isn't.

Does he smoke? Yes, he does./No, he doesn't.

Can you swim? Yes, I can./No, I can't.
