## English Diphthongs

### Diphthongs Definition

- A diphthong is a glide from one vowel to another, and the whole glide acts like one of the long, simple vowels.
- -The diphthongs of English are in three groups: those end in /ʊ/ , as in /əʊ/ and /aʊ/ , and those which end in /ı/ , as in /e ı /, /a ı/ and /ɔ ı/ and those which end in /ə/ as in / ıə, eə , ʊə/.To sum up, the diphthongs are 8 in number.
