on line shopping became popular during the internet boom in 1999 - 2000. Amozon.com, the online bookstore founded by jeff Benzos, created history by becoming the first bookstore with a presence only on internet. Following the success of Amazon, many bookstores with a an physical presence also created an online presence on the internet. Later, portals such as Yahoo.com and MSN.com.

- Create apassword that has at least 10 characters composed of alphabetic, and special characters, an example is "9@jeg2H54!w".
- One way to create a memorable password is to take the first letter of each word in a meaningful (but not overly common) phrase. For example, "3+RiffMs!" is derived from "rhythm is food for my soul".

A shopping cart is a piece of software that acts as an online store's catalog and ordering process. Typically, a shopping cart is the interface between a company's web site and its deeper infrastructure, allowing consumers to select merchandise; review what they have selected; make necessary modifications or additions; and purchase the merchandise.

# How do you shop online :-

- 5. Proceed to checkout and make payment.
