- 1. The designing stage

Test constraints

- Physical resources (administrators, monitors, raters, material)
- Financial resources (money, lab, computers, etc)
- Test security
- Result reporting procedure

2. The developing stage

Test content

test construct, tasks, & behaviours

Test method

- response format & authenticity
- rating, & scoring
- test specifications (test length, materials & their sources)
- 3. The operating stage
 - Trial of test (Feedback & revision)
- 4. The monitoring stage
 - Real test taking (administration)
 - Proctors/ security
 - Scoring and giving results

Two scenarios of authentic test methods

1. Testing listening comprehension in a lecture:

- Taking notes in a lecture is done differently by students
- Reading questions while or before listening (testing listening or memory?)
- Repetition of a recording: repetition doesn't happen in real lectures

2. Speaking test of immigrant teachers

- Write the lecture
- Simulate the lecture with an examiner acting as a student
- Give real lecture in a school
