subject + main verb + object

2-Interrogative Sentences (?)

Do/Does + subject + verb + object

OR

question words + Do/Does + subject + verb + object.

3- Negative sentence

subject + do not/does not + main verb

4- Negative-Interrogative Sentences


Do/Does + subject + not+ verb + object

OR

question words + subject + do not/does not + main verb.



Study tips


• Adverbs commonly used with the simple present tense are: **always, usually, often, sometimes, occasionally, rarely** and **never.** Note that the adverbs of frequency usually go **before** the verb.






