# Present Simple /formula

## 1- Positive sentence

subject + main verb + object

## 2-Interrogative Sentences (?)

Do/Does + subject + verb + object

OR

question words + Do/Does + subject + verb + object.

## 3- Negative sentence

subject + do not/does not + main verb

## 4- Negative-Interrogative Sentences

Do/Does + subject + not+ verb + object

OR

question words + subject + do not/does not + main verb.

- Adverbs commonly used with the simple present tense are: **always, usually, often, sometimes, occasionally, rarely and never.** Note that the adverbs of frequency usually go **before** the verb.



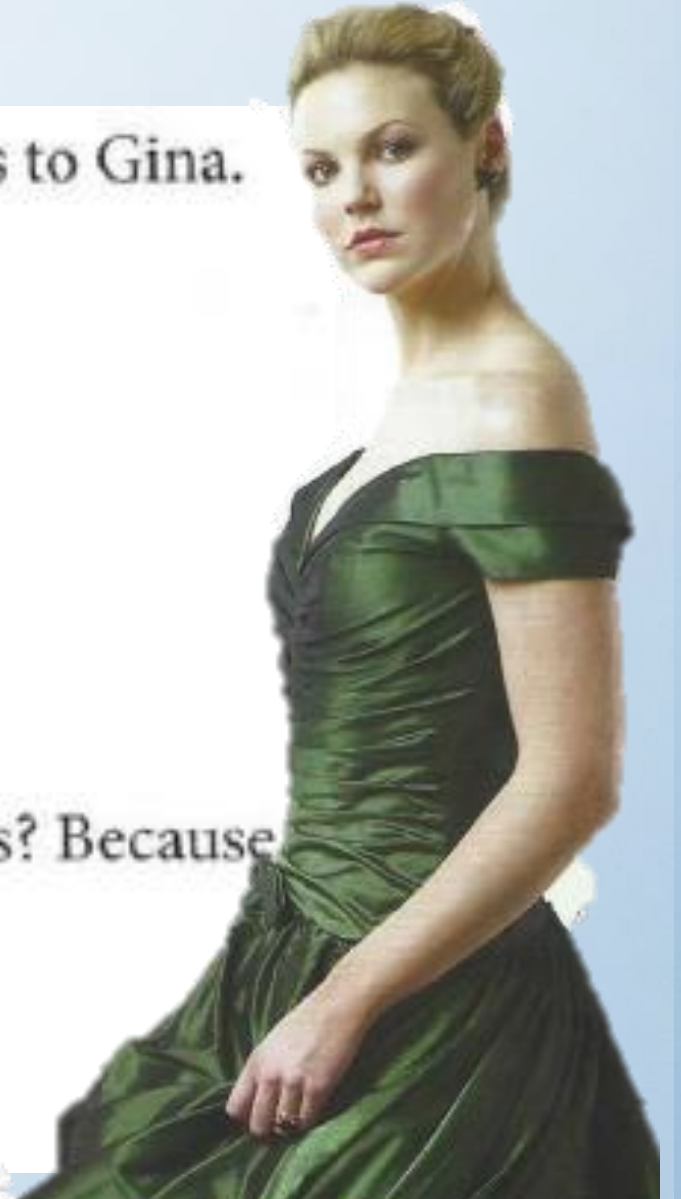

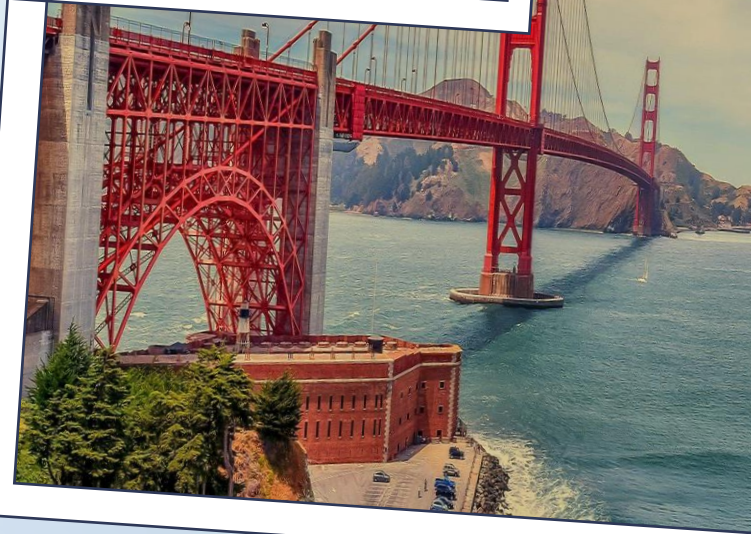
San Francisco is beautiful. It's a big city, with a lot of new buildings, and it isn't expensive. The shops are great, and the Golden Gate Bridge is amazing!

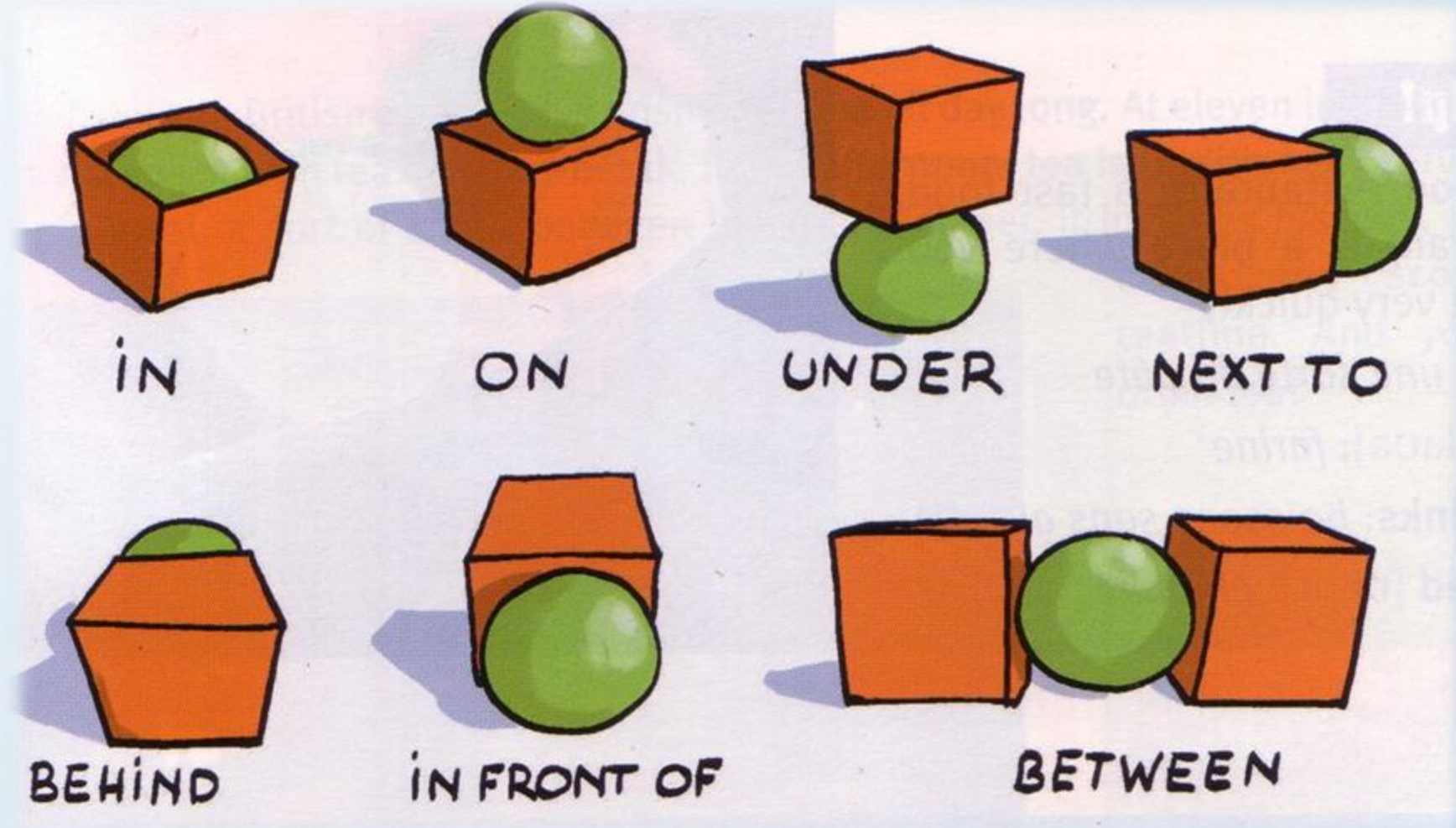
