

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## **Centring Diphthongs**

Centring Diphthongs (ending in /ə/): this group of diphthongs glide towards (end in) the mid-centre area of vowel /ə/. These diphthongs are:

/iə/ /eə/ /ʊə/



/iə/: a centring diphthong; the starting point is in the close-front area of vowel /i/ then glides towards the mid-centre area of vowel /ə/; the lips change from spread to neutral; e.g.: here /hiə/, ear /iə/.

/eə/: a centring diphthong; the starting point is in the midfront area of vowel /e/ then glides towards the mid-centre area of vowel /ə/; the lips change from spread to neutral; e.g.: share /ʃeə/, air /eə/.

/və/: a centring diphthong; the starting point is in the close-back area of vowel /v/ then glides towards the mid-centre area of vowel /ə/; the lips change from rounded to neutral; e.g.: cure /kjvə/, tour /tvə/.
