
S V(Be) Av

- ➤ The verb in this pattern is one of the verbs (to be): is/are/am/was/were/ has been/ will be/ may be/ is being... etc.
- the third position is occupied by (Av) which is an adverb of place or time like, here, there, yesterday, tomorrow, up, downstairs, soon, ...etc

The test was yesterday...... S V(Be) Av

➤ In addition to those adverbs, some prepositional phrases can be considered as adverbs if they refer to time or place.

S V (Be) Av
Your books are on the table.



More Examples:

The danger can be anywhere outside.

My keys were not on the kitchen table.

The interview will be tomorrow.

Are you in the house?

Whatever animal you are talking about is inside the box.
