## Methods of Killing birds

There are different ways to kill birds and every way has its advantages and disadvantages

#### 1. Cervical dislocation

The goal of cervical dislocation is to sever the spinal

cord and separate the vertebrae

so that the bird does not recover consciousness.



## Cervical dislocation

#### **Advantages:**

- 1. Not expensive
- 2. Quick and used anywhere.

#### **Disadvantages**

- 1 Damage the tissues of the body
- 2 The possibility of suffocating the bird as a result of pressure on the trachea
- 3 Causes bleeding brain

## 2 - Electric shock

By passing an electric current through the bird's body. Clamp in the front of the bird and another in the back of the bird 110 v /10 seconds.

#### **Disadvantages**

▶ Bleeding in kidneys


3 - injection of magnesium sulphate solution in the vein or heart.

#### **Disadvantages**


- 1 Affects the tissues of the body.

# Necropsy and carcass disposal

1-Wet down the feathers with a water or disinfectant solution.

2- Put the bird on its back & the head anteriorly.




- 3- Macke an incision in the skin at posterior end of the keel bone.
- 4- Extended the incision to the right and the left side until reaching the right & the left ribs.
- 5- Remove the skin anteriorly until the neck.
- 6- Make an incision in the abdominal muscles to the right & left side.
- 7-Cut the ribs on both sides.


8- Expose the internal organs by removing & examine the breast muscle


9- Examine the organs such as (the liver for any change, the air sacs, the heart for any change, the sciatic nerve should be exposed, And others).

10- Remove & examine the internal organs.


11- Dispose of the carcass properly & disinfect surfaces & tools.
